Items That WILL BE Accepted:

- √ Household cleaners
- ✓ Lab packs acids/bases
- ✓ Lawn and garden chemicals
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Roof and driveway sealers
- ✓ Light bulbs with mercury
- ✓ Lead acid and dry cell batteries
- ✓ Automotive Fluids Motor oil antifreeze
- √ Gasoline, Kerosene
- ✓ Paint and paint related products/Solvents, strippers, turpentine, varnishes

- ✓ Propane cylinders grill sized or smaller
- ✓ Mercury
- ✓ Batteries (Lead Acid/NiCad/Lithium/Alkaline)
- ✓ Organic Acids
- ✓ Fire Extinguishers
- ✓ Pesticides, Herbicides, Insecticides
- √ 4 ft bulbs/8 ft bulbs, Crushed bulbs
- ✓ Lighters

Items That WILL NOT Be Accepted:

- ✗ No Commercial or Business Waste
- ✗ No PCB's, Transformers, Capacitors
- ★ No Compressed Gases (other than propane)
- **✗ No** Explosives/Ammunition

- **X** No Smoke Detectors
- **✗ No** Medical/Infectious wastes
- **✗ No DEA Controlled Substances**
- ✗ No Radioactive wastes
- ✗ No appliances, televisions, computers, tires, general recycling or trash (See Community Collections)
